EVD in DRC


- Update on Ebola in DRC for 7th October
 - Total of 181 cases (146 confirmed & 35 probable), including 115 deaths.
- Over 5700 contacts have been registered, of which 1900 remain under surveillance as of 2nd October
- From 19 to 25 September, a high proportion of contacts ranging between 95-98% were followed up daily;
- Contacts follow-up improved from 78% to 93%

Major city


Health Zone reporting probable or confirmed

- 5. WFP will then contact the field focal point to confirm flight arrival time and to be ready at airstrip for handing over
- WFP will inform (1. Mr. Sombe John 0925742688 and or 2. Mrs. Kiden Theodora 0935706859)
 the WHO Juba focal point for immediate collection at Juba airport.

Note:

- · Sample will be collected within 24 hours
- · Security situation and/or weather may delay the collection of this service
- The field focal point and Juba focal point must be present at least 30 mins in advance of the arrival
 of the aircraft to minimize any delays in handing over the sample.
- Sample must be packed as per the WHO guidelines otherwise it will not be transported
- · Correct documentation must support the sample
- Ad-hoc flight requests may disrupt the normal UNHAS schedule






Update from CM/IPC/SDB

- Ebola vaccination has been done for health workers and contacts in Tchomia; this will limit the risk of further spread to Uganda and South Sudan
- CM/IPC Training plan ready. Training for Juba 15-18 Oct and for Yei 22-25 Oct. Participants both MoH and Partners being identified
- Wau Isolation Facility will be established at the Wau Teaching Hospital as advised by the SMoH and agreed with partners
- Juba and Yei Isolation Facilities will be taken up by WHO
- TWG has reviewed and SOPs for WASH in Isolation Facilities.
 Further review will continue to customize SoPs for various sections
- Training for SDB team for Juba planned for next week- participants to be confirmed with Chair of Subgroup
