

- WHO and MOH notified this morning
- 13 year old
- Diagnosed for malaria and admitted 12th Oct
- Referred from Mundri PHCC to Lui Hospital
- Symptoms: fever, abdominal pain, bleeding
- Sample collected to be sent to Juba for confirmation
- Died 14th Oct
- No travel history to DRC



Update on BO&PEs TWG

- SOP, job aids, training materials, forms and communication materials are finalized and shared
- CDC conducted an evaluation visit to monitor the screening point in Juba International Airport.
- A refresher training will take place next Tuesday
 23/10/18 for screeners at Juba International Airport.
- A non-health stakeholder Ebola awareness training at Juba airport is pending.



Update from Case management and SDB TWGs

- SDB training started today
 - 24 participants (3 teams of 9 members)
 - Training will last for two days
- SoPS for IPC/WaSH (Isolation Facility and ETU, Safe & Dignified Burials) will be validated and in the Case Management TWG next week

Update from Yei River STF

Activity

- On-going active surveillance with UNMISS escorts
- Plans to setup a standalone screening point or to have a mobile screening team
- Plans to establish other screening points at the POEs has being put on hold due to insecurity following the Minyori armed clashes

Action Points

- Quantitative analysis of surveillance activities
- WHO/Partners to avail two vehicles to support the state RRT
- ICRC to explore ways to engage the RRT on the side of the armed groups.
- RRT to share the list of the concerned areas/POEs with ICRC delegate.



SOC MOB/Case Mgt: Yei River STF

Activity

- On-going radio jingles, talk shows (once a week) on two radio stations (Spirit FM and EPC).
- Weekly road drive around the town with the support of SSDO/UNICEF
- Case Mgt trainings planned for next week followed by SDB & IDSR
- UNICEF/SSDO to standardize hand washing facilities at screening points
- SSDO/UNICEF trained 10 chlorinators; provided 10 gumboots, 20 face masks, 10 ctns of sprayers, 2ctns Aqua tabs, 20 pcs of buckets for hand washing facilities.

Action Points

- Need for IEC materials at health facilities and screening points.
- Partners to consider incentives for members participating in the road drive and radio talk show.
- Partners are requested to share reports on their humanitarian response.
- SMoH&E are to share contacts of three focal persons from the RRT to be shared with the NTF for proper communication and information sharing
