- WHO/MoH to provide transport for National Public Health Laboratory (NPHL) team. Inprocess. WHO is considering giving the NPHL team transport subsidy instead of prepositioning vehicle at the NPHL.
- BH/PoE to disaggregate analyzed data at PoE into primary and secondary screenings. Done. Another request to include the states of the points of entries was put across.
- IFRC/SSRC to forward list of volunteers to Epi/Surveillance TWG for possible inclusion as contact tracers. Done. Epi/Surveillance TWG asked to contact Core Group for assistance in nominating possible contact tracers for training.
- RCCE TWG to use target population to standardize data on people reached during RCCE activities. In-process; will comply as soon the population delineations are sourced.
- RCCE TWG to include GPS coordinates of locations for conducted activities. In-process; the application of the action point may not be a priority for now.
- WFP to provide update on the 4 ambulances. In-process. Will request MoH for tax exemptions in due time. Vehicles to be procured from Dubai.
