








Women 15-19 years married by age 15


Percentage of 15-19 year olds M currently married or in union (%) 14


Proportion of adolescent girls vaccinated for HPV to prevent cervical cancer (%)

| 3  | Maternal conditions          | 14.60            | 7.8                     |  |  |
| 4  | Tuberculosis                 | 12.82            | 6.8                     |  |  |
