HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (29/10/2020)

- A total of 12907 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 0.5% of the population of approximately 2.5 Million people.
- More male cases 7112 (55.1%) were recorded compared to female cases 5795 (44.9%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 518 (4.0%) Health Care Workers (HCWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
 - -336 (64.9%) State; 179 (34.5%) Private, 3 (0.6%) NGO.
 - -280 (54.4%) recoveries including 3 (0.6%) deaths.
- Today (29/10/2020), 28 recoveries have been recorded from 4 regions; the recovery rate now stands at 85.2%.



- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; 7 and Erongo regions reported the highest with 5829 (45.2%) and 3943 (30.5%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 104 (78.2%) are COVID-19 deaths while 29 (21.8%) are COVID-19 related deaths.
- The cases continue to erupt among closed settings such as schools, police holding cells and prisons.

- To date, 125732 tests (including (6187 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 30762 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 68 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 9 regions.
- Cumulatively, 23672 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 3122 (24.2%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 5827 (83.1%) out of 7014 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 1: Distribution of suspected and confirmed COVID-19 cases by District, 29 October 2020




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, as of 29 October 2020

- A highest peak of 2123 (16.4%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 2).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases to 52 in epi-week 43.
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (29/10/2020), **897** calls were answered including **107** alerts.

Table 3: Number of people in mandatory quarantine facilities, 29 October 2020

- Since March 2020, 18795 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 524 people are currently in quarantine, with 7 new admissions in the last 24 hours.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases. as of 29 October 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 9137 (70.8%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- The under 5 years age group make up 314 (2.4%) of the total cases whereas, 575 (4.5%) are above 60 years of age.
- A total of **1589** (**12.3%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Virtual training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services

CHALLENGES

- Refusal of swabbing by some people
- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.
- Inadequate ICU facilities and ICU equipment at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthening of awareness measures on the importance of testing.
- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
- Provision of fully equipped ICU facilities at referral hospitals and high care units in the districts.
