# HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (11/11/2020)

- A total of **13345** cases have been recorded todate, representing **0.5%** of the population of approximately **2.5** Million people.
- More male cases 7351 (55.1%) were recorded compared to female cases 5994 (44.9%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 527 (3.9%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - -345 (65.5%) State; 179 (34.0%) Private, 3 (0.6%) NGO.
  - -280 (53.3%) recoveries including 3 (0.6%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 91.3%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 5977 (44.8%) and 3972 (30.0%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 106 (78.5%) are COVID-19 deaths while 29 (21.5%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- A highest peak of 2123 (15.9%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases to 32 in epi-week 45.
- The number of cases have plateaued in the last four weeks as seen in the graph.
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (11/11/2020), 696 calls were answered including 70 alerts.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 11 November 2020

- To date, 136909 tests (including (6513 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 32814 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 103 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 30250 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4073 (30.5%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2344 (97.6%) out of 2401 active contacts were monitored.

Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases as of 11 November 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 9402 (70.5%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **1663** (**12.5%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 329 (2.5%) of the total cases whereas, 609 (4.6%) are above 60 years of age.

- Since March 2020, 19309 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 276 people currently quarantine, with 14 new admissions in the last 24 hours.

- Virtual training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- > The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

### CHALLENGES

Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
