# HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (12/11/2020)

# TODAY Tested 1081 Confirmed 27 Active 989 Recovered 55 Death 3

- A total of 13372 cases have been recorded todate, representing 0.5% of the population.
- More male cases 7363 (55.1%) were recorded compared to female cases 6012 (44.9%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 530 (4.0%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - 347 (65.5%) State; 180 (33.9%) Private, 3 (0.6%) Non-Government Organisation.
  - 280 (53.3%) recoveries and 3 (0.6%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 91.6%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 5984 (44.8%) and 3977 (29.7%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 107 (77.5%) are COVID-19 deaths while 31 (22.5%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- A highest peak of 2123 (15.9%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- After a peak in epi-week 34, the country has seen a gradual reduction in the average number of confirmed cases to 32 in epi-week 45.
- The number of cases have plateaued in the last four weeks as seen in the graph.
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (12/11/2020), 637 calls were answered including 84 alerts.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 12 November 2020

- To date, 137990 tests (including (6529 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 32919 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 105 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 30333 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4082 (30.5%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2383 (98.1%) out of 2428 active contacts were monitored.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases as of 12 November 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 9426 (70.5%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **1663** (**12.4%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 329 (2.5%) of the total cases whereas, 610 (4.6%) are above 60 years of age.

- Since March 2020, 19375 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 304 people currently quarantine, with 66 new admissions in the last 24 hours.

Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.

Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
