HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (07/12/2020)

- A total of 15298 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 0.6% of the population.
- More male cases 8295 (54.2%) were recorded compared to female cases 7003 (45.8%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 594 (3.9%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
 - 397 (66.8%) State; 194 (32.7%) Private, 3 (0.5%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 530 (89.2%) recoveries and 3 (0.5%) deaths.

- The recovery rate now stands at 91.5%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 6935 (45.3%) and 4197 (27.4%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 117 (76.5%) are COVID-19 deaths while 36 (23.5%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Since March 2020, 21027 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 666 people are currently in quarantine, with 58 new admissions in the last 24 hours.





Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 07 December 2020

- A highest peak of 2123 (13.9%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (07/12/2020) **869** calls were answered including **75** alerts.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 10598 (69.3%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2112 (13.8%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 359 (2.3%) of the total cases whereas, 710 (4.6%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 166008 tests (including 7109 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 37734 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 192 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 34476 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4376 (28.6%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3446 (100%) out of 3446 active contacts were monitored.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Expanded Targeted Testing is being conducted at institutions that have confirmed positive cases.
- > Virtual training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as schools, police holding cells and prisons.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
