- The cases continue to flare up among the school premises and hostels.
- A total of **14416** cases have been recorded to-date, representing **0.6%** of the population.
- More male cases **7877** (**54.6%**) were recorded compared to female cases **6539** (**45.4%**).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 558 (3.8%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 370 (66.3%) State; 185 (33.2%) Private, 3 (0.5%)
 Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 530 (95.7%) recoveries and 3 (0.5%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94.3%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 6483 (45.0%) and 4057 (28.1%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 116 (76.8%) are COVID-19 deaths while 35 (23.2%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 30 November 2020

- To date, 155763 tests (including 6857 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 36324 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 123 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 33490 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4251 (29.5%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3255 (99.6%) out of 3269 active

- Of the total confirmed cases, 10012 (69.5%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 1932 (13.4%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 348 (2.4%) of the total cases whereas, 677 (4.7%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 30 November 2020

- A highest peak of 2123 (14.7%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 2).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (30/11/2020) **684** calls were answered including **59** alerts.

- Since March 2020, 20458 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 483 people currently are quarantine, with 102 new admissions in the last 24 hours.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Expanded Targeted Testing is being conducted at institutions that have confirmed positive cases.
- Virtual training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as police holding cells and prisons.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
