HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (10/12/2020)

- A total of **16097** cases have been recorded to-date, representing **0.6%** of the population.
- More male cases 8692 (54.0%) were recorded compared to female cases 7405 (46.0%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 637 (4.0%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 422 (66.2%) State; 211 (33.1%) Private, 4 (0.6%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 530 (83.2%) recoveries and 3 (0.5%) deaths.

- The recovery rate now stands at 89.0%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 7480 (46.5%) and 4296 (26.7%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 120 (75%) are COVID-19 deaths while 40 (25%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- Since March 2020, 21216 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 733 people are currently in quarantine, with 54 new admissions in the last 24 hours.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 10 December 2020

- A highest peak of 2123 (13.2%) cases was recorded during week 34 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 10 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 11188 (69.5%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **2178** (**13.5%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 372 (2.3%) of the total cases whereas, 749 (4.7%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 170901 tests (including 7174 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM and Namib Poultry laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 38618 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 222 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 35454 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 4526 (28.1%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- > Today, 3339 (97.7%) out of 3416 active contacts were monitored.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)

- Expanded Targeted Testing is being conducted at institutions that have confirmed positive cases.
- Virtual training on Integrated Disease Surveillance Response (IDSR) is ongoing country-wide.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

Lack of isolation units and facilities in the country for special cases in closed settings such as schools, police holding cells and prisons.

Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for identified special cases throughout the country.
