## **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (03/01/2021)**



- ➤ A total of 25386 cases have been recorded todate, representing 1% of the population.
- More male cases 13028 (51.3%) were recorded compared to female cases 12358 (48.7%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1170 (4.6%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - 879 (75.1%) State; 287 (24.5%) Private, 4 (0.3%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 747 (63.8%) recoveries and 4 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 83.4%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 11982 (47.2%) and 5663 (22.3%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 173 (79.4%) are COVID-19 deaths while 45 (20.6%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 03 January 2021

Today (03/01/2021) 800 calls were answered including 60 alerts.

- To date, 213100 tests (including 9095 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 48810 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 344 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 41879 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5634 (22.2%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3852 (61.6%) out of 6258 active contacts monitored.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 03 January 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 17732 (69.8%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 3004 (11.8%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 556 (2.2%) of the total cases whereas, 1457 (5.7%) are above 60 years of age.

Table 3: Number of people in mandatory quarantine facilities, 03 January 2021

- Since March 2020, 25473 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1486 people are currently in quarantine, with 76 new admissions.
