HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (29/12/2020)

- A total of 23333 cases have been recorded to-date, representing
 0.9% of the population.
- More male cases 12075 (51.8%) were recorded compared to female cases 11258 (48.2%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1029 (4.4%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 752 (73.1%) State; 273 (26.5%) Private, 4 (0.4%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 747 (72.6%) recoveries and 3 (0.3%) deaths.

- The recovery rate now stands at 84.2%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 11300 (48.4%) and 5276 (22.6%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 152 (77.6%) are COVID-19 deaths while 44 (22.4%) are COVID-19 related




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, As of 29 December 2020

- A highest peak of 3209 (13.8%) cases was recorded during week 52 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (29/12/2020) 1000 calls were answered including 72 alerts.

- To date, 204625 tests (including 8497 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 46707 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 324 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 10 regions.
- Cumulatively, 40359 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5405 (23.2%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 4383 (72.4%) out of 6054 active contacts monitored.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 29 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 16380 (70.2%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2802 (12.0%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 505 (2.2%) of the total cases whereas, 1249 (5.4%) are above 60 years of age.
