HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (25 /12/2020)

- ➤ A total of 21398 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 0.9% of the population.
- More male cases 11175 (52.2%) were recorded compared to female cases 10223 (47.8%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 901 (4.2%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
 - 628 (69.7%) State; 269 (29.9%) Private, 4 (0.4%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 574 (63.7%) recoveries and 3 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 83.4%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 10390 (48.6%) and 4909 (22.9%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 144 (77%) are COVID-19 deaths while 43 (23%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- To date, 196839 tests (including 7930 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 45249 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 365 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 8 regions.
- Cumulatively, 39099 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 5182 (24.2%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 5593 (94.6%) out of 5910 active contacts monitored.

- A highest peak of 2684 (12.5%) cases was recorded during week 52 (Figure 1).
- The National Call center continues operation for 24 hours daily.

Today (25/12/2020) **780** calls were answered including **59** alerts.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 25 December 2020

- Of the total confirmed cases, 15056 (70.4%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 2598 (12.1%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 459 (2.1%) of the total cases whereas, 1094 (5.1%) are above 60 years of age.

- Since March 2020, 24269 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1617 people are currently in quarantine, with 54 new admissions.

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the regions.

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities throughout the country.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures.
