- A total of 34372 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 1% of the population.
- More male cases 17388 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 16984 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1631 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 todate.
  - 1255 (77%) State; 372 (23%) Private, 4 (0.2%)
     Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 1463 (90%) recoveries and 6 (0.4%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 14434 (42%) and 6987 (20%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 291 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 68 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

## **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA**




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases

A highest peak of 3485 (10%) cases was recorded during week 53 (Figure 1).

The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.

Today (02/02/2021), **705** calls were answered including **79** alerts.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 02 February 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 23592 (69%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 4123 (12%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 799 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2211 (6%) are above 60 years of age.
- To date, 266461 tests (including 11297 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 62325 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 217 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 57568 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 7859 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3071 (69%) out of 4482 active contacts monitored.

- Since March 2020, 31347 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 982 people are currently in quarantine, with 31 new admissions.

- Mechanisms are underway on how to roll out the vaccine nationwide once it is made available.
- Public awareness on COVID-19 prevention measures is ongoing.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

## **CHALLENGES**

- Lack of isolation units and facilities in the regions.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities throughout the country.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
