# **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (09/02/2021)**

A total of 35242 cases have been recorded to-date, repres	senting 1% of the population.

- ▶ More male cases 17854 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 17388 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1663 (5%) Health Workers (HWs) have tested positive for COVID-19 to-date.
  - > 1278 (77%) State; 377 (23%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - > 1598 (96%) recoveries and 6 (0.4%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 96%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 14637 (42%) and 7130 (20%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 305 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 73 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.



- Since March 2020, 32450 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1147 people are currently in quarantine, with 120 new admissions.

A highest peak of 3485 (10%) cases was recorded during week 53 (Figure 1).




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases, as of 09 February 2021

Of the total confirmed cases, 24130 (68%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.

- A total of 4274 (12%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make 820 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2284 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

- To date, 274798 tests (including 11386 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry and Central Veterinary laboratories.
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 64354 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 442 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 59926 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 8254 (23%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 924 (24%) out of 3890 active contacts monitored.

# **PUBLIC HEALTH ACTION(S)**

- Mechanisms are underway on how to roll out the vaccine nationwide once it is made available.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise continuation of essential health services.

Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
