

HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (08/03/2021)

- A total of 40337 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 20417 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 19920 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1810
 (4%) are Health Workers (HWs).
 - 1410 (78%) State; 396 (22%)
 Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1749 (97%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 94%.



- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 15532 (39%) and 7543 (19%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 353 (80%) are COVID-19 deaths while 91 (20%) are COVID-19 related deaths.




Figure 1: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases

- Of the total confirmed cases, 26384 (65%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of 6353 (16%) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 914 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2528 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

To date, 311863 tests (including 11610 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath and Central Veterinary laboratories.

Since the beginning of the outbreak, 72860 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 609 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 14 regions.


Cumulatively, 68568 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 10039 (24%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.

Today, 2402 (60%) out of 4003 active contacts monitored.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 08 March 2021
