HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (10/03/2021)


TOTAL Tested 314877 Confirmed 40631 Active 2069 Recovered 38104 Death 450



- A total of 40631 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 20559 (51%) were recorded compared to female cases 20072 (49%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1828 (4%) are Health Workers (HWs).
 - 1427 (78%) State; 397 (22%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1749 (96%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- > The recovery rate now stands at 94%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 15631 (38%) and 7566 (19%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 358 (80%) are COVID-19 deaths while 92 (20%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

Of the total confirmed cases, 26556 (65%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.

- A total of **6417 (16%)** of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up
 919 (2%) of the total cases whereas,
 2550 (6%) are above 60 years of age.


To date, 314877 tests (including 11629 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath and Central Veterinary laboratories.

- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 73657 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 332 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 12 regions.
- Cumulatively, 69747 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 10207 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 2709 (74%) out of 3682 active contacts monitored.




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 10 March 2021
