# **HIGHLIGHTS/SITUATION UPDATE (26/03/2021)**

- A total of 43499 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- More male cases 21956 (50%) were recorded compared to female cases 21543 (50%).
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1940 (4%) are Health Workers (HWs).
  - 1524 (79%) State; 409 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 1810 (93%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 16179 (37%) and 7919 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 410 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 98 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.





Figure 1: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 26 March 2021

Table 2: COVID-19 specimen recorded at the Laboratories, 26 March 2021

- To date, 338533 tests (including 11744 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 78839 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 491 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 9 regions.
- Cumulatively, 73472 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11001 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3325 (73%) out of 4566 active contacts monitored.

Figure 2: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 26 March 2021

- A highest peak of 3485 (8%) cases was recorded during week 1 in 2021 (Figure 2).
- The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (26/03/2021), 569 calls were answered including 23 alerts.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 28018 (64%) are in the 20-49 years agebrackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- ➤ A total of **7201 (17%)** of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 994 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2778 (6%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 3: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 26 March 2021

- Since March 2020, 40692 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1729 people are currently in quarantine, with 67 new admissions.

- Honourable Minister of Health and Social Services launched a national COVID-19 vaccination programme in Windhoek.
- The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise the continuation of essential health services.

#### **CHALLENGES**

- Lack of isolation units and facilities for cases detected in boarding schools.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for cases in schools.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of
