- A total of 45039 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 1976 (4%) are Health Workers.
 - 1542 (78%) State; 418 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
 - 1941 (98%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- The recovery rate now stands at 96%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 16417 (36%) and 8070 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 445 (81%) are COVID-19 deaths while 103 (19%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION IN NAMIBIA




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 06 April 2021

- A highest peak of 3485 (8%) cases was recorded during week 1 in 2021 (Figure 1).
- ➤ The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- Today (06/04/2021), 579 calls were answered including 22 alerts.





Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 06 April 2021

- Of the total confirmed cases, 28719 (64%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **7737** (**17%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1027 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 2871 (6%) are above 60 years of age.

Cumulative_confirmed cases per 100 000 people






Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 06 April 2021

- To date, 351545 tests (including 11793 retests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 81698 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified, 241 new contacts were identified within the last 24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 77163 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11454 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 1861 (45%) out of 4108 active contacts monitored.

- Since March 2020, 42114 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1229 people are currently in quarantine, with 181 new admissions.

The government and developmental partners continue to prioritise the continuation of essential health services.

CHALLENGES

- Lack of isolation units and facilities for cases detected in boarding schools and police holding cells.
- Non-adherence to COVID-19 prevention measures by the general public.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish fully equipped isolation units and facilities for cases detected in schools and police holding cells.
- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
