- A total of 47941 cases have been recorded to-date, representing 2% of the population.
- Cases are equally distributed by gender at 50%.
- Of the total confirmed cases, 2064 (4%) are Health Workers.
  - 1627 (79%) State; 433 (21%) Private, 4 (0.2%) Non-Governmental Organizations.
  - 2005 (97%) recoveries and 6 (0.3%) deaths.
- > The recovery rate now stands at 95%.
- All fourteen (14) regions have reported confirmed cases; Khomas and Erongo regions reported the highest with 17037 (36%) and 8559 (18%) respectively.
- Of the total fatalities, 512 (82%) are COVID-19 deaths while 116 (18%) are COVID-19 related deaths.

- To date, 378699 tests (including 11903 re-tests) have been conducted by NIP, Path-Care, NAMDEB, UNAM, Namib Poultry, Diagno, NAMPath, Namibia Central Pathology and Central Veterinary laboratories
- Since the beginning of the outbreak, 87131 contacts of confirmed cases have been identified,
  237 new contacts were identified within the last
  24 hours from 11 regions.
- Cumulatively, 82681 contacts have completed their monitoring period, while a total of 11866 (25%) contacts of confirmed cases have tested positive.
- Today, 3377 (92%) out of 3681 active contacts monitored.




Figure 1: Epi-curve for confirmed COVID-19 cases, 25 April 2021

- The highest peaks of 3463 (7%) and 3485 (7%) cases were recorded during week 53 of 2020 and 1 of 2021 respectively (Figure 1).
- ➤ The National Call Center continues operations for 24 hours daily.
- ➤ Today (25/04/2021), **507** calls were answered including **18** alerts.

- Since March 2020, 44556 people have been placed into mandatory quarantine facilities around the country.
- A total of 1459 people are currently in quarantine, with 14 new admissions.

- Of the total confirmed cases, 30215 (63%) are in the 20-49 years age-brackets which constitutes the majority of the recorded cases.
- A total of **8465** (**18%**) of the confirmed cases are among the 5-19 years category.
- The under 5 years age group make up 1097 (2%) of the total cases whereas, 3142 (7%) are above 60 years of age.




Figure 2: Age and Sex distribution of COVID-19 confirmed cases 25 April 2021




Figure 3: Distribution of cumulative confirmed cases per 100 000 by region, 25 April 2021

- Continue to give awareness on the importance of adhering to COVID -19 prevention measures; with the involvement of the Security Cluster.
