




## **Situation Report 63** Data update as of 27<sup>th</sup> November 2022 at 22 :00 HRS



## Background

On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2022, the Ministry of Health declared an outbreak of Sudan Ebola Virus (SVD) after a case managed at Mubende Regional Referral Hospital (MRRH) in Mubende district was confirmed through testing at the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI). This followed investigations by the National Rapid Response Team of suspicious deaths that had occurred in the district earlier in the month. This is the first time in more than a decade that Uganda reports an outbreak of Sudan ebolavirus

n = 0 cases missing date of onset and not shown


- Today marks 72 days of responding to the EVD outbreak.
- Within the past 24 hours, there was one new confirmed case that was a death registered in ETU, there was no recovery reported.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) among confirmed cases still stands 56/142 (39%).
- A total of 532 contacts actively being followed-up in five districts, follow-up rate in the past 24 hours was 85%.



#### Actions to date

The Ministry of Health (MoH), Districts, and partners in Uganda are implementing several outbreak control interventions in Mubende and her surrounding districts to contain the disease spread. An overview of key activities is summarized below:

Response Pillar	Key Updates in the past 24 hours

Surveillance &	Solution Active contacts in the past 24-hours are 532 within five districts. Follow up rate stands at $85\%$ .
Contact tracing	Total alerts validated from districts with active contacts within the past 24-hours were 35, of which 21 met the suspected case definition and 11 were evacuated.

## Key messages to the public

People in the community should call an alert hotline or go to a health facility if they have symptoms (e.g., fever, headache, weakness, vomiting, bloody diarrhoea or urine, bleeding from body openings).

- Sommunity should not fear people who have been discharged from the ETU and returned home.
