





Data update as of 28th November 2022 at 22:00 HRS




On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2022, the Ministry of Health declared an outbreak of Sudan Ebola Virus (SVD) after a case managed at Mubende Regional Referral Hospital (MRRH) in Mubende district was confirmed through testing at the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI). This followed investigations by the National Rapid Response Team of suspicious deaths that had occurred in the district earlier in the month. This is the first time in more than a decade that Uganda reports an outbreak of Sudan ebolavirus

- Today marks 73 days of responding to the EVD outbreak.
- Within the past 24 hours, there was no new confirmed case or death registered in ETU, there was no recovery.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) among confirmed cases still stands 56/142 (39%).
- A total of 512 contacts actively being followed-up in five districts, follow-up rate in the past 24 hours was 77%.




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#### Person analysis of affected persons as of 28th November 2022 at 22:00 HRS

#### **Actions to date**

The Ministry of Health (MoH), Districts, and partners in Uganda are implementing several outbreak control interventions in Mubende and her surrounding districts to contain the disease spread. An overview of key activities is summarized below:

Daily DTF meetings in all affected districts happened normally including Jinja and Masaka, NTF meetings are thrice a week.

- Security personnel strategically positioned to enforce presidential lockdown directives from Kassanda and Mubende
- Active contacts in the past 24-hours are 512 within five districts. Follow up rate stands at 77%.
- Total alerts validated from districts with active contacts within the past 24-hours were 62, of which 37 met the suspected case definition and 21 were evacuated.
- Uploaded 59 results for 16 districts with 00 district registering a confirmed case.
- Cumulative samples tested are 3,943 with 142 testing POSITIVE for EVD (SUD)
- Bed occupancy rates within the past 24 hours stood at 13/86 (15%) in Mubende isolation units.
- The quarantine facility in Jinja has been operationalised, there are 07 high risk contacts currently.
- Within the past 24 hours, teams undertook a total of 42 EMS evacuations (Mubende 32, Kassanda 08, Kampala 00, Masaka 00, and Jinja 02). Two (02) clients declined evacuation.
- Team experiencing challenges of impassable roads due to heavy rains.
- A total of 18 death alerts received from three districts (Mubende, Kassanda and Jinja), all 18 were verified and samples collected from all 18 of the alerts.
- Onducted 15 safe and dignified burials in Mubende, Kassanda within the past 24 hours cumulative SDBs conducted currently stand at 515 (217 SBDs conducted in Kassanda)
- Two (02) backlog case in the past 24 hours family were not yet ready.
- Four radio talk shows: one in Kyegegwa, one in Mubende, and two in Jinja.
- At least 140 radio spots/messages continue to be aired daily through the local radio stations in Mubende, Kassanda, Kagadi/Kakumiro, Buyangabu, Jinja, Masaka and Kyegegwa.
- Ommunity sensitization activities ongoing in Jinja, Masaka, Kassanda, Mubende, and Kampala.
- A total of 124 households were reached with EVD messages during the integrated RCCE/Active case search by VHTs in Bukesa parish, Kampala..
- Supported the orientation of Local Councilors from Central Division in Kampala to mobilize the communities and participate in the Accelerated RCCE/EVD campaign. 36 councilors were in attendance including the Resident City Commissioner.
- In Jinja, the team conducted 06 community dialogue meetings with traditional healers in the villages of Nakati, Kanama, Lubowa, Nalinaibi and ilongo village in Busedde sub-county and 71 individuals were reached with EVD prevention messages.
- 7-days of community sensitization through the Boda-boda runners targeting the boda-boda stages and as well distributing Ebola IEC materials in Masaka.

Orders and Deliveries

- Weekly and Bi-weekly orders (PPE and selected Case management commodities) sent to NMS to support the ETU and priority districts respectively.
- Adequate Stock available at national level (NMS, WHO, UNICEF warehouses) for PPE, IPC/WASH and Laboratory consumables and pipeline on track for coveralls, thermometers from WHO and UNICEF

Logistics

#### Food and Fleet Management

- Fleet maintained to support Surveillance, Coordination, Laboratory, SDB, Surveillance, CES and other activities.
- All ETUs are being provided with meals
- The continues to offer transport services for Consumables from NMS to all the affected districts and Last Mile Delivery to PFP/PNFP sites.
- **ETU SUPPORT:** Supportive counseling offered to four confirmed clients; Psychosocial support offered to 34 clients at the emergency ward, Madudu and MOW ETU.
- **RESETTLEMENT**: Five clients from ETU MOW, 08 clients from ETU Madudu were escorted back home.
- SURVIVOR FOLLOW-UP: Clinic runs on Monday, Wednesday.

Mental Health & Psychosocial Social Support

#### Key messages to the public

- People in the community should call an alert hotline or go to a health facility if they have symptoms (e.g., fever, headache, weakness, vomiting, bloody diarrhoea or urine, bleeding from body openings).
