Background

On 20th September 2022, the Ministry of Health declared an outbreak of Sudan Ebola Virus (SVD) after a case managed at Mubende Regional Referral Hospital (MRRH) in Mubende district was confirmed through testing at the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI). This followed investigations by the National Rapid Response Team of suspicious deaths that had occurred in the district earlier in the month. This is the first time in more than a decade that Uganda reports an outbreak of Sudan ebolavirus

Key Highlights

Today marks 102 days of responding to the EVD outbreak and 30 days since the last confirmed case.

- Within the past 24 hours, there was no new confirmed case or death registered; there was no recovery.
- Case Fatality Ratio (CFR) among confirmed cases still stands 55/142 (39%).
- No active contacts are currently under follow-up.

Daily case incidence Confirmed and probable, with 3-day moving average





Figure: Time analysis of affected individuals

Actions to date

The Ministry of Health (MoH), Districts, and partners in Uganda are implementing several outbreak control interventions in Mubende and other affected districts to contain the disease spread. An overview of key activities is summarized below:

Response Pillar Key Updates in the past 24 hours Ð Regular District Task Force meetings are ongoing in all affected districts The bi-weekly National Task Force meetings will resume on 6th January 2023. Coordination Plans for de-escalation of response activities undergoing in all affected districts. Total alerts validated in the past 24 hours were 26 from Mubende, Masaka, KMA, Kassanda and Jinja districts; five met the suspected case definition and four were evacuated. Ð In the past 24-hrs, a total of 46 alerts received from eight CAT #2, #3 districts. All tested NEGATIVE for Surveillance & EVD (SUD) Contact tracing Dotal of 14,167 individuals were screened at nine Points of Entry (POEs), where seven health alerts were investigated, and none met the EVD suspected case definition. € Active case search performed in 27 healthcare facilities of Mubende € Total of 71 samples were processed at UVRI and the mobile labs in Kampala and Mubende within the past 24hrs; the average number of samples processed daily within the past seven days stands at 41. Laboratory Cumulative samples tested are 5,646 with 142 testing POSITIVE for EVD (SUD) Ð Zero confirmed cases on admission currently, routine patient care services are ongoing in all ETUs. Case Management \bigcirc Beds occupied in suspected wards are 03/30 in the new ETU Mubende. Ð In the past 24-hrs, five evacuation alerts were received: Mubende (2), Masaka (1), and Jinja (2). Emergency Medical Ð Of the five alerts, two EVD-related evacuations were made within the past 24-hrs, and the other three were Services (EMS) non-Ebola alerts Ð Within the past 24 hours, a total of 17 death alerts were verified from Mubende and Kassanda. O Conducted 13 safe and dignified burials in Mubende and Kassanda within the past 24 hours and collected nine Safe & Dignified Burials samples. Ð Cumulative SDBs conducted in Mubende: 464, Kassanda: 368, and eight in Jinja θ Team Mubende conducted IPC follow-up and assessment on adherence to EVD SOPs and transmission-based WASH and precautions in 10 facilities along the Mubende highway. The scores were between 55 - 72%. The team mentored Infection Prevention 36 health workers on screening, chlorine preparation, temperature taking and readings, environmental cleaning and Control (IPC) and decontamination, sterilization, risk perception, IPC Surveillance, and management of spillages. Ð At least 160 radio spots messages continue to be aired daily through 10 radio stations: Kyegegwa (08), Kagadi Rick (06), Kassanda (10), Kakumiro (10), Mubende (39), Masaka (36), Sembabule (13), Kazo (20), Kabalore (22), and Communication & Jinja. Ð Public Awareness Messages aired on 12 active Community Audio Towers (CATs) in both Masaka City and District. Ð Team Kasanda issued 250 Ebola Luganda posters.
