Dear Participant,

The Government of the Republic of Zambia welcomes you to Lusaka for the Seventy-fifth session of the WHO Regional Committee for Africa (RC75), to be held from 25 to 27 August 2025 at the Mulungushi International Conference Center (MICC) – Kenneth Kaunda Wing.

Please, find below some useful general information on travel to the city of Lusaka in Zambia and the logistical arrangements in place for the smooth conduct of the Regional Committee session.

#### Visas

Citizens of 167 countries worldwide do <u>not</u> require a visa to enter Zambia (refer to: <a href="https://www.zambiaimmigration.gov.zm/nationals-who-dont-require-visa/">https://www.zambiaimmigration.gov.zm/nationals-who-dont-require-visa/</a>).

The following paragraphs do not apply to citizens from the 167 countries referred to above:

While citizens of 34 countries require a visa on arrival, and citizens of 51 other countries are usually required to arrange for a visa in advance of their travel, the Government of Zambia will facilitate the issuance of a **visa on arrival for registered delegates coming into Zambia for RC75** from all of these countries. A dedicated visa counter will be provided at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport. The list of countries that require a visa to enter Zambia is available at <u>e-Services</u>.

Passports must be valid for at least six months from the date of entry into Zambia. The passport booklet must also contain at least two (2) blank pages before entry into Zambia.

Single-entry visas cost US\$ 25 and are valid for a maximum of 90 days. A support letter will be availed to all participants to facilitate the issuance of the visa on arrival.

Holders of the United Nations Laissez-Passer (UNLP) are exempt from visa requirements to enter Zambia.

## Airport reception and transfers

On arrival, the necessary assistance will be provided by members of the Organizing Committee. To facilitate the process, you are urged to **send your flight details to the RC75 Secretariat at your earliest convenience, but no later than 7 August 2025**, via the online registration platform (<a href="https://indico.un.org/e/RC75">https://indico.un.org/e/RC75</a>). The same applies to information for

delegates arriving by land.

The Organizing Committee will facilitate the transfer of official participants from the Kenneth Kaunda International Airport to their recommended hotels in Lusaka. A dedicated RC75 information desk will be available at the airport.



#### Transport within and outside Lusaka during your stay in Zambia

Participants are advised to contact their hotels for personal movements at their own cost.

During the meeting, shared transport for participants to and from selected hotels within a radius of 15 km around the conference

facilities shall be provided. A schedule of pickup and drop off times and contact numbers of logisticians shall be shared in due course. As you arrive in Zambia, if you encounter any problems regarding transport, please contact Mr Goodson Kamanga on +260 9736668620.

Further, transport services (equivalent to Uber) are available in Lusaka for participants to use at their own discretion. The service providers are Yango and Bolt, and users are advised to download the app.

All delegates who wish to hire vehicles for personal use to travel around in Zambia are free to do so. The country is safe for holidays and movements. Most cars have right-hand drive systems. The recommended car hire companies are provided in Annex 3.



## Hospitality and accommodation

Participants are required to book and pay for their accommodation. The list of recommended hotels for delegates to RC75 is attached as Annex 2. It is recommended that you make your reservation in one of these hotels. Note that transfer of participants from the hotels to MICC, the meeting venue, is only provided for the recommended hotels in Annex 2.

Note that August is peak tourism season in Lusaka. Participants are advised to make their own reservation as early as possible as rooms could quickly become unavailable due to the anticipated increased demand during the period of the Regional Committee. To make a reservation, please refer to Annex 2, which provides the rates according to the room type, and the contact details of each hotel.

Delegates are therefore advised to make their reservation in good time.



## Registration and badges

All information about confirmation of participation, including flight details, requirements for obtaining the Zambian entry visa, and hotel reservations should be communicated through the online registration platform at https://indico.un.org/e/RC75.

Annex 1 of this document provides a guide for online registration. Should you need assistance, please contact the WHO Country Office or send an email to <a href="mailto:afrgorcregistration@who.int">afrgorcregistration@who.int</a>.

Participants will be required to register online and obtain identification badges prior to the opening of the Regional Committee session. For identification and security purposes, the official badge should be worn by all participants at all times during the Regional Committee session and at official social functions.

Distribution of badges will be between 08:00 and 20:00, starting on Saturday, 23 August 2025 at the conference venue.



## Catering

Coffee breaks and lunch will be served free of charge to participants during the Regional Committee session.

#### Climate

Zambia has a tropical climate, with a distinct rainy and dry season. The dry season runs from April to October. During this time, rainfall is low, temperatures are pleasant, and days are sunny. As RC75 will be hosted in August, mornings are expected to be cold and afternoons to be warmer.



## **Currency and banking hours**

The **Kwacha** (ZMW) is the currency of Zambia. It is subdivided into 100 ngwee. It is the only accepted currency in the country. Major credit cards, including VISA, MasterCard, and American Express are widely accepted. The exchange rate ranges from around 28 ZMW to US\$ 1.

## **Banking Hours in Zambia**

Banking hours in Zambia are typically from 08:30 to 16:00. However, some banks operate with extended hours. Delegates are encouraged to check with their Protocol Officers or the specific bank's website for up-to-date information.

All major banks have automated teller machines (ATMs or cash dispensers) that accept Visa and MasterCard. Major foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks and Bureaux de Change outlets located at the airport and in nearby shopping malls, including **Manda Hill Mall**, **Arcades Mall**, **and East Park Mall**. ATMs are available 24/7.

N.B. Delegates are advised against exchanging any currency on the street or black market.

#### **Business and shopping hours**

Most offices in Zambia operate from **08:00 to 13:00** and **14:00 to 17:00**, Monday to Friday. On Saturdays, business hours may vary, but many offices remain open from **08:30 to 12:30**.

Shopping malls generally close at **18:00** daily, while major supermarkets often extend their hours until **20:00**, except on Sundays when they may close earlier.

Entertainment facilities have varying operating hours depending on their location and type of venue.

## Communication

Free internet access will be available at the Mulungushi International Conference Center for the duration of the meeting.

There are three main mobile network providers in Zambia: Zamtel, Airtel and MTN. SIM cards are available for approximately ZMW 5.00. However, it is a legal requirement in Zambia for all SIM cards to be registered before activation. Registration can be completed at any of the service providers' outlets, and a valid form of identification will be required.

## Medical and health services

Delegates are strongly encouraged to obtain international medical insurance before travel.

A medical team from the Ministry of Health will be present at the conference venue to provide free basic health care services and to respond to any emergencies throughout the meeting.

A sick bay will be available at the venue, where delegates can consult with health care practitioners. In cases requiring further medical attention or in the event of a serious medical emergency, referrals will be made to the nearest appropriate public health facility.



### **Emergency medical services**

Delegates in need of medical assistance are advised to visit the sick bay at the conference venue. Delegates on long-term medication are advised to carry sufficient supplies throughout their stay in Zambia.

All emergency hospital services for delegates will be arranged by the medical personnel covering the meeting.

#### Medical coverage and cost

Delegates attending the meeting are advised to obtain their medical health insurance before travelling to Zambia. Basic medical services will be provided by the Ministry of Health during the conference at KKICC. The medical staff will consist of doctors, nurses and emergency care personnel. However, the cost of medical prescriptions, hospital admissions and other medical evacuations will be borne by the delegates or their sponsors.

Delegates are advised to obtain international medical insurance cover with a reputable insurance company that should be recognized by the major hospitals in Zambia.

Delegates who are living with any chronic medical condition(s) for example: diabetes mellitus, hypertension, asthma, epilepsy, HIV/AIDS or others and are on treatment, are advised to travel with their medicines and ensure that they have a sufficient supply throughout their stay in Zambia.

#### Travel immunization and disease screening

Delegates travelling from yellow fever-endemic countries as per the WHO list are required to show proof of vaccination and must carry their yellow fever vaccination card at the point of entry into Zambia (visit the WHO website for more information).

There are *No* other specific vaccines required for entry into Zambia. However, delegates are encouraged to ensure they are up to date with required routine vaccinations from their country.

While Lusaka is generally considered a malaria-free zone, delegates are advised to consult their doctors before travel and use mosquito repellents as a precaution. Delegates are encouraged to maintain personal health security at all times.

## **Security**

Ministers, heads of delegations, and all VIPs attending RC75 will receive the necessary security arrangements as prescribed by Zambia's Diplomatic Security.

To facilitate the entry of armed security agents accompanying delegates, the delegations concerned should contact the Diplomatic Security at the Ministry of Home Affairs and Internal Security through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, who will in turn facilitate clearances of firearms.

Security measures will be extended to selected hotels and the conference venue.

Access to the conference hall will require the presentation of a session-specific badge.

Official vehicles will be identified by a designated sticker.

Lusaka is generally a secure travel destination with minimal risks. However, visitors should take the following precautions:

- avoid going out alone at night or on foot;
- opt for crowded areas when moving around;
- do not leave valuables at the meeting venue;
- inform someone of your destination if you are travelling outside the meeting area.

## **Electricity**

Zambia operates on a 220–240V supply voltage at 50Hz and uses two plug types: C and G outlets. Participants are strongly advised to bring a universal adaptor that will be compatible with both types of plug sockets.





## Spoken languages



The official language of Zambia is English. The most widely spoken languages in Lusaka are Chinyanja and Bemba. Here below are some useful expressions in that language.

Hello = Bwanji/Shani How are you? = Mulibwanji/Mulishani Goodbye = Bye Welcome = Takulandilani/Mwaiseni Thank you (very much) = Zikomo/Natotela Excuse me/please = Zikomo Yes = Yeo/Eyamukwai

### **Guide for online registration**

- (a) Copy and paste this link into your Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari or Opera web browser: <a href="https://indico.un.org/e/RC75">https://indico.un.org/e/RC75</a>;
- (b) On the *RC75* page, click on the link *Register now*;
- (c) You will be redirected to the connection page. Next, click on *Create a new account*;
- (d) Fill in the form that appears, and click on *Confirm*;
- (e) You should receive an account activation email after a few minutes;
- (f) Click on the account activation link to activate your account;
- (g) Your account is now active and you will be redirected to the RC75 page.
- (h) If you are not yet connected, you can do so using your new username and your Indico password. You may use this same account in the Indico system for all other governing body meetings of the Regional Office for Africa.
- (i) The registration form for the conference has been pre-filled with some of your details. Please, upload an identification document with a photo or use the Webcam to take a photo; then populate all fields on the form. Click on *Register* when you finish filling the form.
- (j) You will receive an automatic email acknowledging receipt of your registration form. Subsequently, you will receive an email informing you on whether your request has been approved.
