2 - Program duration: 4 years (2021-2024)

3-Zone Program of action: Region Tillaberi

4 - Justification

The region of Tillaberi faces : (1) a multidimensional crisis (environmental, security, humanitarian and economic) ; (2) growing migration challenges ; (3) challenges related to access and use of basic social services (education and health in particular) ; (4) an under-exploitation of the agro- sylvo -pastoral and fishery potential and its human capital.

The "approach Pipeline rural" aims to help communities in the region to develop any local potential (human capital, physical resources, etc.) to sustainably address the key challenges they face and stay loyal to their region. It favors multi sectorial and multi-actor interventions, strong synergy and full involvement of stakeholders, as well as the optimization of funding opportunities for high-impact interventions, in favor of the populations of the region.

5 - Overall objective of the Program

Contribute to inclusive socio-economic development of the region of Tillaberi, is through the implementation of the approach "Pipeline Rural"
