



## 219 million cases of malaria

In 2017, five countries accounted for nearly half of all malaria cases worldwide. Four of them are in Africa:






### A total of 582 million

insecticide-treated mosquito nets

were delivered globally between 2014 and 2016.





#### 505 million

of the nets were destined for sub-Saharan Africa.



#### **Household** ownership

of at least one such net increased from 50% in 2010 to 80% in 2016 across sub-Saharan Africa.



Today more than half of the people at risk of malaria in Africa sleep under one of these nets, compared with just 29% in 2010.
