## Proposals for Member States of the African Region to serve on the Executive Board and as officers of the Board

The terms of office of Togo, Cameroon, Comoros and Lesotho on the Executive Board will end with the closing of the Seventy-ninth World Health Assembly in May 2026.

In accordance with resolution AFR/RC54/R11, which decided the arrangements to be followed in putting forward each year the Member States of the African Region for election by the Health Assembly, Regional Committee decided as follows:

(a) **Côte d'Ivoire, Guinea, Mozambique, and South Sudan** to replace Togo, Cameroon, Comoros, and Lesotho, respectively, beginning with the one-hundred and fifty-ninth session of the Executive Board in May 2026, immediately following the Seventy-ninth World Health Assembly. The Executive Board would therefore be composed of the following Member States of the African Region as indicated in the table below:

- (b) Cote d'Ivoire for election to serve as Vice-Chair of the Executive Board as from the one-hundred and fifty-ninth session of the Executive Board.
- (c) Cabo Verde for appointment to replace Comoros to serve on the Programme Budget and Administration Committee (PBAC) as from the one-hundred and fifty-ninth session of the Executive Board. The PBAC would therefore be composed of Cabo Verde and Zimbabwe from the African Region.
- (d) **Mozambique for appointment to replace Togo** to serve on the Standing Committee on Health Emergency Prevention, Preparedness and Response (SCHEPPR) as from the one-hundred and fifty-ninth session of the Executive Board. The SCHEPPR would therefore be composed of the Central African Republic and Mozambique from the African Region.
