Proposal for officers of the Seventy-ninth session of the World Health Assembly

The Regional Committee for Africa decided to propose that the Chairperson of the Seventy-fifth session of the Regional Committee for Africa be designated as Vice-President of the Seventy-ninth session of the World Health Assembly.

Furthermore, based on the English alphabetical order and subregional geographic groupings, the Regional Committee for Africa decided to propose the following countries to serve on the Main Committees of the Seventy-ninth World Health Assembly:

- (a) Uganda to serve as Rapporteur of Committee A;
- (b) Ghana to serve as Chair of Committee B;
- (c) South Africa, Sierra Leone, Kenya, and United Republic of Tanzania to serve on the General Committee;
- (d) Senegal, Sao Tome and Principe, and Eswatini to serve on the Committee on Credentials.
